

Privacy Policy 2025

At Gwithian Surf School, a trading name of St Ives Bay Adventure Group Ltd, we respect your privacy and are committed to protecting your personal data. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, and safeguard the personal information you provide to us, and explains your rights in relation to that information.

1. Information We Collect

We collect personal data when you interact with us through our website, booking system, over the phone or during your visit to our surf school. This includes:

- Personal Identifiers: Name, email address, phone number, age, and gender.
- **Booking Information:** Date of booking, surf lesson preferences, equipment rental details, and payment information.
- **Health and Safety Data:** Medical conditions, allergies, and emergency contact details (only when necessary for your safety during lessons).
- Website Usage Data: IP address, browser type, device information, and usage patterns (via cookies and analytics tools).

2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

- **To Provide Services:** To book and manage surf lessons, rentals, and other services you request.
- **Communication:** To send confirmations, reminders, or updates about your bookings or upcoming lessons.
- **Customer Support:** To respond to inquiries, provide assistance, and resolve any issues.
- **Marketing:** To send promotional emails, offers, and newsletters, which you can optout of at any time.
- **Compliance:** To comply with legal obligations, such as safety regulations and reporting requirements.

3. How We Protect Your Data

We take reasonable precautions to protect your personal information from unauthorised access, loss, misuse, or alteration. These include:

- Using secure methods to process payments (e.g., encrypted transactions).
- Storing data on protected servers and using firewalls to block unauthorized access.
- Limiting access to your data to authorized staff members who need it to provide services.

4. Data Sharing

We do not share your personal information with third parties except in the following circumstances:
